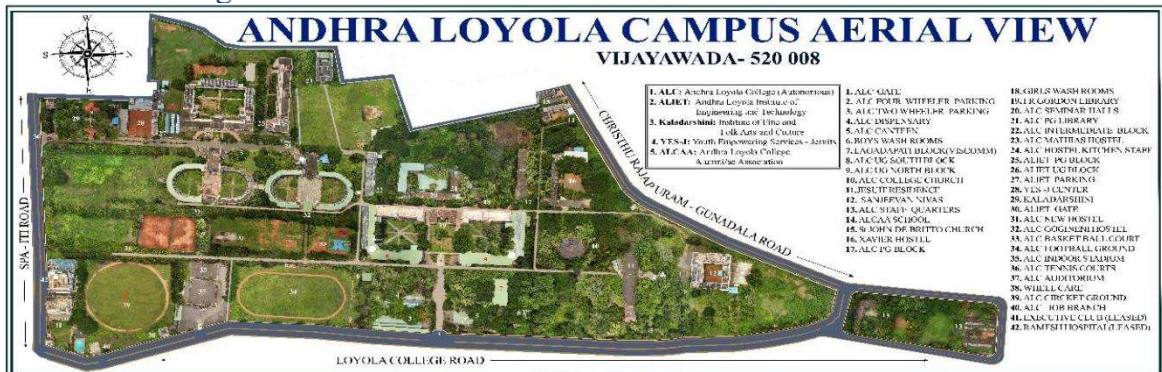

About Andhra Loyola College

Andhra Loyola College (ALC) was founded in 1953 and completed 68 years of excellence in higher education since 1954.
